

Wireless Printing (for Windows users) is now available in the Student Technology Center

The Marcus White Student Technology Center/Computer Lab is now set up for wireless printing. This gives students the capability of printing to an STC/Computer Lab printer via their laptop (connected wirelessly to the CCSU campus network). Students are able to send a document to an STC printer and then go to a print station and release the document to a printer. Standard printing charges apply – costs are subtracted from print credit or blue chip money.

How does it work?

You must be successfully logged into the CCSU wireless network in order to download and install the client software and to print. This requires Clean Access and Windows Updates to be active on your laptop. Go to www.ccsu.edu/wireless for more information.

Download the “STC/Computer Lab Wireless Printing” file from our IT software downloads page at www.ccsu.edu/its/downloads and follow the instructions below to install.

Installation instructions:

1. Double-click on the downloaded executable and select “Install” at the installation window.
2. Select “Finish” when the package completes the installation.
3. When you are ready to print from any application on your laptop, go to the File menu and select Print. You will see four extra printers to select from. Select the appropriate CCSU Black&White or Color printer with the appropriate Double or Single sided printer combination.
4. A Print Job Details pop-up box will ask for your BlueNet ID (username) and the name of your document. Enter the appropriate information.
5. Proceed to a print station in the STC and swipe your blue chip card. Select your document (based on the information you provided in step 4) and click Print. Be sure to check the lower left corner of the screen to see where your document is printing.
6. You have 30 minutes to go to a Print Station to release your document. After 30 minutes, your document will automatically be deleted.
