### **Areas of Strategic Investments for CCSU – Final Discussion**

IPC members reviewed the “Recruitment, Onboarding and Student Support Services Inventory” developed by L. Bigelow as a follow-up to this discussion at the last meeting. It was noted that the document is meant to represent a “visual map of services” currently offered, and serve as a baseline for future discussions.

  - Card Office
  - Student Activities and Leadership Development
  - Counseling Center
  - Man Enough and HEALTHY fellows initiatives
  - Administrative Affairs, Facilities, Physical Campus and Campus Police
  - Computer Labs
  - Writing Center
- The Honors Program should be added under “recruitment”
- L. Bigelow indicated that she would update the document and have copies available for the next IPC meeting.

### **Priorities for Facilities Plan**

R. Bachoo provided a detailed overview of current and future capital projects.

#### **ACTION ITEMS:**

- Z. Toro and R. Bachoo will meet with Library Committee members to discuss changes they would like to see to the physical space that will meet the needs of staff and students.
- Z. Toro noted that a process needs to be established to allocate space that becomes available. An overall master list is also needed, that shows who is going where.
- R. Bachoo indicated that he would give IPC members a copy of the master list document that was previously discussed.
- After discussion, IPC members unanimously agreed that the Student Center expansion should be the top priority noted in the Facilities Plan.
