- Three letters of recommendation (preferably from your instructors);
- Evidence of citizenship or immigration status (you must be a US citizen or permanent resident to be eligible for this program). Acceptable documents include a copy of birth certificate or passport for US citizens, or a copy of the green card for permanent residents.
