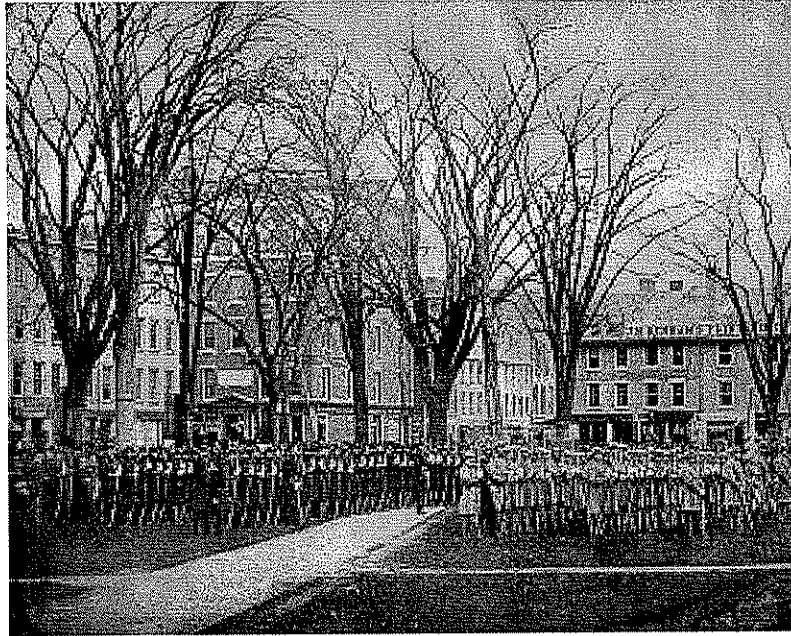

THE MOST IMPORTANT DAY
OF THE CIVIL WAR

DECEMBER 13, 1862

FREDERICKSBURG, VA

THE PRINCIPAL CITY
BETWEEN WASHINGTON
AND RICHMOND

Soldiers credited to New Haven had two days in the war with more casualties: May 3, 1863 at Chan-cellorsville, VA (185) and March 8, 1865 at Kinston, NC (172). The 85 casualties at Fredericksburg, VA however, were the most serious. Fourteen soldiers were killed, 67 were wounded, and 4 were captured in the 14TH, 15TH and 27TH Connecticut. Twelve of the wounded died.

The date December 13, 1862 ranks 10TH for total casualties (253) (40 killed, 5 missing, 200 wounded, 6 captured, 2 wounded & captured) for a single day for the State of Connecticut. All of the casualties were at Fredericksburg.

The Battle of Fredericksburg (December 11-15, 1862) ranks 13TH for total casualties (253) for an engagement for the State of Connecticut. The most intense fighting was on December 13. New Haven had all of its casualties on that day.

The Battle of Fredericksburg with 85 total casualties for New Haven was the 3RD highest number of casualties for any single engagement of the war for the city. The 2ND highest number of casualties (172) was at the Battle of Kinston, NC (March 8, 1865) and the highest number of casualties (187) was at the Battle of Chancellorsville, VA (May 1-3, 1863).

In November 1862, 120,000 Union troops under Ambrose Burnside met 75,000 Confederates under Robert E. Lee at Fredericksburg. After weeks of delay the Federals crossed the Rappahannock River and entered the city. After several furious Union attacks on the Confederate positions on the heights above the city, the Federal army was driven back with appalling loss.

Thirty seven New Haven soldiers died in captivity. Sixteen died at Andersonville Prison, GA, 7 died at Libby Prison, Richmond, VA, 7 died at Salisbury, NC, and one died at each of the following: Ashland, VA, Charleston, SC, Millen, GA, Petersburg, VA.

FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE WERE WOUNDED

The first New Haven soldiers wounded were Leonhardt Lyon of Rifle Company D, 1ST Connecticut Infantry and George C. Brandeau, Jacob Sneider of Company H, 3RD Connecticut Infantry. All were wounded at the First Battle of Bull Run, VA on July 21, 1861 and recovered from their wounds. Fifty-seven New Haven soldiers died from wounds received during the war.
